Individual sporting achievements of a young disabled sportsperson.

Team of the Year

Successes and achievements by an amateur team in their sport at local, country, regional or national level.

Junior Team of the Year - U18

Successes and achievements by a Junior team, in their sport at local, country, regional or national level.

Volunteer of the Year

Successes are achievements of an unpaid volunteer, highlighting the positive difference they have made to the local community/club.

Junior Sports Leader of the Year - U18

Individual sporting achievements of a young sports leader.

Coach of the Year

Successes and achievements of a qualified coach who has supported the development of sport in a club and local community.

Club of the Year

Quality of activities, recruitment, inclusiveness, local links and environmental values, and the progression of the club in the past 12 months.

Special Olympics Award

Recognise those who participate in this category.
